- Review and issue all Plumbing, Sewage System and Backflow Preventor Permits.
- Perform building and HVAC Inspections of buildings under Part 9 of the Ontario Building Code.
- Examine plans for Site Plan approval and plumbing systems for commercial, industrial, institutional and multi-residential construction projects.
- Prepare and issue reports, letters and Orders in relation to on-site inspections and plans examination.
- Issue Provincial Offence Notices and Informations under the Provincial Offences Act and attend court, as necessary, to ensure compliance with the Ontario Building Code and Municipal By-laws.
- Establish and maintain good relations with the public, professionals and City staff.
- Act as the City's representative at the Ontario Backflow Prevention Association.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
